Qualifications

School employee members are elected by school employees, and parents are elected by parents of students attending the school. Membership terms are for two years. If needed, elections are held at the beginning of each school year. Members elected to the council then select council officers in the initial meeting on Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at 6:00pm in the Copper Hills High School Media Center.
