Are you interested in taking SLCC concurrent enrollment classes
at Copper Hills High School?
Follow these easy steps to get the process started.

Step 1- Go to SLCC's Concurrent Enrollment Website.

Use the Concurrent Enrollment website: <http://www.slcc.edu/concurrentenrollment/index.html>

Step 2-Find the Concurrent Student Section

- Scroll down to find the Concurrent Student Section in the middle of the page
- Click on the "Become a SLCC Student" link
- Play the 4:45 minute video.
- Scroll to the bottom of the page to click on the blue "Apply for Admissions" button.
- Enter the required information.
 - You will need to pay the \$40.00 admissions fee at this time
 - You will also need to have your State Student Identification (SSID). This is found on the profile page of your Skyward account.

Step 3-Wait for a Reply Letter.

- Your SLCC student number, called your "S" number, will arrive in the mail a few days after you complete the application.
- Record your number where you won't lose it and can access it quickly (e.g. your mobile device, etc.)

Step 4-Take the Accuplacer Test (CPT) or Send ACT Scores to SLCC

- This is required for **Math, English, and Science** Classes. (See other side for requirements)
- You may take this at a SLCC campus Testing center, www.slcc.edu/testing or during the open window test dates at Copper Hills High School.
- You must wait 48 hours after applying to take the Accuplacer (CPT) test
- **IF** you are qualifying by ACT scores, visit <http://www.actstudent.org/> to send your scores to SLCC. (This is only required if you did not put SLCC as one of your 5 school choices when you took the test.)

Step 5-Set up your "MyPage" Account.

- Please follow the instructions listed under Admission Steps, Step 3 on the SLCC Concurrent Enrollment website.
- You will need your "S" number to do this.
- When it calls for the last four digits of your of your Social Security Number, you may also use the last four digits of your "S" number, if you prefer.
- Make sure you remember your MyPage username and password. You will need it for registration.

**ALL OF THESE STEPS MUST BE COMPLETED ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE
START OF CLASS TO GUARANTEE YOUR SPOT.**



Are you taking Weber State concurrent enrollment classes at Copper Hills High School?

Follow these 4 easy steps to apply and register.

Step 1 & 2-Apply for Weber State Admission.

Use the Concurrent Enrollment website: <http://weber.edu/concurrent/>

- Click on the "Get Started" button in the middle of the page.
- Watch the video on how to apply
- Click on the "Admissions" link
- Click on the green "Apply Online" button
- You will need to have your State Student Identification (SSID). This is found on the profile page of your Skyward account.
- You will need to pay the \$30.00 admissions fee at this time

Step 3-Sign up for a Wildcat Username and Password.

This is available 24 hours after paying the admissions fee to Weber State

- Go to <https://portalapps.weber.edu/getwcid/>
- Enter your birthday and social security number in the format shown
- Click Continue
- Your username and temporary password will appear. Write down your username so you don't forget it. Highlight and copy the password.
- Click Continue. You will be taken to the Password Self Service page <https://wildcatid.weber.edu>
- Enter your Wildcat Username and paste the temporary password.
- Click on "Login" button
- Change your password. Make sure to write it down so you don't forget!

Step 4-Step Register for Your Class and Pay Tuition

Use the Concurrent Enrollment website: <http://weber.edu/concurrent/>

- Click on the "Get Started" button in the middle of the page.
- Scroll down to the Step 4 Registration section
- Click on "Registration Page"
- Select Copper Hills High School
- Click on the "By Subject"
- Click on the subject of your course
- Click on the Add button next the course listed for your subject.
- Click "View and Continue" in the bottom right corner
- Verify the class and click register in the bottom right corner
- Sign in with your username and password if you are not already signed in
- Click on "Continue"
- Accept the Registration Disclosure
- At the Payment Options screen, click on "Proceed to Payment"
- Choose your method of payment
- Pay the concurrent enrollment tuition of \$5.00 per credit hour
- Tuition payment MUST be made at time of registration. There are no pay later options.



Are you taking Snow College concurrent enrollment classes at Copper Hills High School?

Follow these steps to apply and register.

Step 1-Apply

- Use the website: <https://apply.snow.edu/>
- Select Concurrent Enrollment
- Select the term you plan to begin taking classes
- Enter the required information
- Enter the required information
- If it asks for your State Student Identification (SSID), it is found on the profile page of your Skyward account.
- You will need to pay the \$30.00 admissions fee at this time

Step 2-Obtain your Badger ID

- Go to www.snow.edu
- Select Academics right about the pictures
- Select BadgerWeb Log In
- Select Snow Username and Badger ID Lookup
- Enter the required information.
- Click on Submit to obtain your Badger ID

Step 3-Register Into a Class

- Go to <https://www.snow.edu/academics/concurrent/>
- Scroll down to the “Get Started” section
- Select Copper Hills High School
- Find your class and write down the CRN number
- Click on the Register link
- Enter your BadgerID and password
- Click on the Student Tab
- Click on Add/Drop Classes
- Select the semester
- Enter the CRN number
- Click on Submit Changes
- You should now see you are registered into the class
