Honor Cords

The Honor cord program was designed to give the student a more in-depth educational experience in one or more specific interest areas. Each Honor Cord will have specific academic and experiential requirements that will deepen the students learning. As part of the experiential learning component students may be required to participate certain extracurricular groups, clubs, fairs or contests, complete an activity or athletic letter, create a project or complete an internship. The student will need to be aware of the requirements in each specific Honor Cord area because all Honor Cord areas have both academic and experiential requirements. Students can earn an Honor Cord in any category. Honor Cords are a Copper Hills High recognitions so only classes taken grades 10, 11, 12 will be counted towards this recognition.

Recognition through the Honor Program

- 1. The student will receive one Enhanced Diploma per qualifying area.
- 2. The student will wear a Colored Cord(s) on their graduation robe for each qualifying area. (Students who qualify for an Honor Cord(S) will be required to pay a \$5.00 fee before they can be picked up)
- 3. The student will be acknowledged on the graduation program for earning one or more Emphasis areas.
- 4. The student's transcripts will reflect all Emphasis areas earned.
- 5. The student will be awarded a Pride Pin for each Emphasis earned.
